COMPLAINT

COMES NOW, Plaintiff Jimmie Cavin, by and through his undersigned counsel, and for a cause of action alleges as follows:

INTRODUCTION

- 1. This is a suit brought under Article 16, Section 13 of the Arkansas Constitution, which permits Arkansas citizens to challenge the unlawful use of public funds on behalf of themselves and all similarly situated taxpayers. Furthermore, Plaintiff alleges that the Defendant violated Article 12, Section 5 of the Arkansas Constitution by unlawfully donating public money to private entities.
- 2. The City of Fort Smith unlawfully directed taxpayer funds to private organizations and nonprofits, including the Mercy Hospital Ball, the Fort Smith Round Table Juneteenth Celebration, Steel Horse Rally, Inc., multiple golf sponsorships, Twisted Effects Braid Studio, LLC, and "Begin a New Generation (BANG)", in violation of Article 12, Section 5 of the Arkansas Constitution, thereby constituting an illegal exaction under Article 16, Section 13. In the 2024 fiscal year, the City of Fort Smith allocated \$668,481 to the Mayor's Office. (Exhibit A of the 2024 Operating Expense Budget) This budget was prepared by City Administrator Carl Geffken and

approved by the Fort Smith Board of Directors. Of that \$668,481, Mr. Geffken and the Fort Smith Board of Directors allocated line items in the budget to fund these unlawful expenditures.

- 3. These unlawful expenditures, as described below, constitute an illegal exaction, directly harming the taxpayers of Fort Smith. This lawsuit seeks declaratory relief to affirm these violations of the Arkansas Constitution. It further seeks an injunction to prevent the continued misuse of public funds.
- 4. While charitable organizations serve important roles in communities, it is not the role of government officials to decide which private organizations should receive taxpayer money. Public funds are collected to serve public purposes—such as infrastructure, public safety, and essential services—not to subsidize private charities or nonprofit initiatives. Taxpayers should have the freedom to decide for themselves whether to support certain charitable organizations, rather than having government officials make those decisions on their behalf using taxpayer money. This lawsuit seeks to ensure that our taxpayer money is being spent in accordance with the law and to hold public officials accountable for violating constitutional prohibitions against the misuse of public funds.

JURISDICTION AND VENUE

- 5. Plaintiff, Jimmie Cavin, a resident and taxpayer of Arkansas, challenges the unlawful use of public funds by the City of Fort Smith in violation of the Arkansas Constitution.
- 6. The Arkansas Supreme Court has stated: "Citizens have standing to bring a public-funds case because they have a vested interest in ensuring that the tax money they have contributed to the state treasury is lawfully spent. Thus, the only standing requirements we have imposed in public-funds cases is that the Plaintiff be a citizen and that he, or she, have contributed tax money to the general treasury." Nelson v. Berry Petroleum Co., 242 Ark. 273,413 S.W.2d 46 (1967).

7. Jurisdiction and venue are proper in this Court as the events giving rise to this action occurred in Sebastian County, Arkansas, and the parties are located therein.

PARTIES

- 8. Jimmie Cavin is an Arkansas taxpayer and brings this action as a private citizen to challenge the unauthorized actions of the City of Fort Smith and to protect the interests of the City of Fort Smith from the unlawful appropriation of public funds for private purposes without proper authority.
- 9. The City of Fort Smith, Arkansas, is a municipal corporation governed by a board of directors. The City operates under a City Administrator form of government, with the board responsible for legislative functions, including the approval of the mayor's annual budget and oversight of municipal expenditures. The mayor is tasked with executing duties as defined by applicable statutes and ordinances, subject to the constraints of the board's governance and the requirements of the Arkansas Constitution.

COUNT 1: Unlawful Use of Municipal Funds on Mercy Hospital Ball

- 10. The Mercy Foundation of Fort Smith is a domestic nonprofit organization that hosts the annual Mercy Hospital Ball, a charitable fundraising event. (See Exhibit B, Secretary of State Entity Profile).
- 11. In 2023, the City of Fort Smith and Mayor McGill initially donated \$2,500 for a table at the Mercy Ball. (See Exhibit C, Mercy Ball Invoice, dated November 17, 2023).
- 12. Following this initial pledge, City Administrator Carl Geffken authorized the purchase of a second table for an additional \$2,500. (See Exhibit D, Email from Carl Geffken).
- 13. Both invoices were paid using City of Fort Smith funds from a municipal account, resulting in at least \$5,000 in taxpayer money being donated to a private nonprofit organization.

- 14. The 2024 budget for the City of Fort Smith allocated \$10,000 for the Mercy Ball, as reflected in the expense report. (See Exhibit A, 2024 Expense Report for the Fort Smith General Operating Fund).
- 15. Two separate invoices for the 2024 Mercy Ball reflect payments from City funds: the first invoice for \$2,500 for a table and a second invoice for an additional \$2,500 for another table. (See Exhibits E and F, Mercy Ball Invoices for 2024).
- 16. On information and belief, this \$5,000 payment was classified as a donation and was made without any written agreement or contract for services between the City of Fort Smith and Mercy Foundation of Fort Smith.

COUNT 2: Unlawful Use of Municipal Funds for Juneteenth Celebration

- 17. The Fort Smith Round Table is an independent 501(c)(3) charitable organization that organizes an annual Juneteenth Celebration. (Exhibit G, Secretary of State Entity Profile)
- 18. According to the Fort Smith Round Table's website, Mayor George McGill founded the organization in 2006. (Exhibit H)
- 19. In 2024, Mayor McGill and the City of Fort Smith donated \$15,000 in taxpayer funds to support the Juneteenth Celebration hosted by the Fort Smith Round Table. This donation was made to a private charitable organization that the mayor himself founded. (Exhibit I; Juneteenth Invoice; Exhibit J, Juneteenth Purchase Order)
- 20. This \$15,000 payment was made using taxpayer money from the Fort Smith General Operating Fund, as referenced in Exhibit A.
- 21. On information and belief, this \$15,000 payment was classified as a donation and was made without any written agreement or contract for services between the City of Fort Smith and The Fort Smith Round Table.

COUNT 3: Unlawful Use of Municipal Funds to Steel Horse Rally, Inc.

- 22. The Steel Horse Rally, Inc., is a domestic nonprofit organization that organizes the annual Steel Horse Rally, a large motorcycle rally in downtown Fort Smith. (Exhibit K, Secretary of State Entity Profile)
- 23. According to the 2024 expense budget for the Fort Smith General Operating Fund, the City of Fort Smith allocated \$10,000 within Mayor George McGill's portion of the budget for the Steel Horse Rally. (Exhibit A).
- 24. Mayor George McGill authorized a \$4,000 donation to Steel Horse Rally, Inc., as documented in a purchase order. (See Exhibit L, Purchase Order, date July 9, 2024).
- 25. According to an email exchange between a representative of Steel Horse Rally, Inc. and City Administrator Carl Geffken, the \$4,000 donation was for a title sponsorship at the 2024 Steel Horse Rally. (See Exhibit M, Email Exchange).
- 26. On information and belief, this \$4,000 payment was classified as a donation and was made without any written agreement or contract for services between the City of Fort Smith and Steel Horse Rally, Inc.

COUNT 4: Unlawful Use of Municipal Funds for Golf Sponsorships

- 27. According to the 2024 Operating Expense Fund Report, the City of Fort Smith allocated \$12,000 for Mayor George McGill's portion of the budget for various golf sponsorships. (See Exhibit A).
- 28. A portion of this taxpayer money was donated to the Championship Fore Charities event organized by Girls, Inc. of Fort Smith, a nonprofit organization. (See Exhibit N, Girls, Inc. Business Profile from Secretary of State website). According to a purchase order dated October 7, 2024, and an invoice directed to Mayor McGill, the City of Fort Smith and Mayor McGill used

\$1,000 in taxpayer funds to sponsor participation in the golf event at Hardscrabble Golf Course alongside members of the Fort Smith Board of Directors and other City employees. (See Exhibit O, Purchase Form and Invoice from Girls, Inc.).

- Another portion of the taxpayer money was directed to the Community Rescue Mission Golf Tournament at Ben Geren Golf Course. (See Exhibit P, Community Rescue Mission Invoice, dated May 28, 2024). The Community Rescue Mission, Inc. is recognized as a 501(c)(3) charitable organization. This donation of taxpayer money was made to sponsor a golf team in the tournament, which included Mayor McGill, members of the Fort Smith Board of Directors, and other City employees.
- 30. On information and belief, Mayor McGill and the City of Fort Smith also donated taxpayer money to participate in the Jack White Legislative Golf Tournament, which took place on June 10, 2024, and was organized by the Fort Smith Chamber of Commerce. According to an email dated May 7, 2024, Mayor McGill and City Administrator Carl Geffken participated in this event alongside members of the Fort Smith Board of Directors and other City employees. (See Exhibit Q, Email chain).
- 31. Additionally, Mayor McGill and the City of Fort Smith donated \$2,500 in taxpayer funds to sponsor the "Chip in Fore the Kids" golf tournament organized by the Fort Smith Boys & Girls Club, a domestic nonprofit corporation. (Exhibit R).
- 32. These taxpayer-funded donations were made without any written agreement or contract for services between the City of Fort Smith and the organizations receiving the funds.

COUNT 5: Unlawful Use of Municipal Funds to Twisted Effects Braid Studio, LLC

- 33. On July 30, 2024, Mayor George McGill and the City of Fort Smith authorized a \$2,000 payment of taxpayer money to Twisted Effects Braid Studio, LLC, a for-profit limited liability company. (See Exhibit S, Payment Order, dated July 30, 2024).
- 34. Twisted Effects Braid Studio, LLC, is a private, for-profit business that provides hair products and services. (See Exhibit T, Business Profile from Secretary of State website). According to the associated invoice, the \$2,000 payment was used for a back-to-school event and involved the purchase of braid products, hair extensions, and accessories. (See Exhibit U, Twisted Effects Braid Studio Invoice).
- 35. This payment represents an unlawful expenditure of taxpayer funds to a private forprofit business, further deviating from the constitutional mandate that public funds be used exclusively for public purposes.
- 36. These taxpayer funds were allocated without any written agreement or contract for services between the City of Fort Smith and Twisted Effects Braid Studio, LLC.

COUNT 6: Unlawful Use of Municipal Funds to "Begin a New Generation (BANG)"

- 37. On July 31, 2024, the City of Fort Smith and Mayor George McGill authorized a \$2,006.99 donation of taxpayer funds to "Begin a New Generation (BANG)." (See Exhibit V, Purchase Order, dated July 31, 2024).
- 38. According to the associated invoice, the payment was for the purchase of backpacks for a back-to-school event. (See Exhibit W, Invoice from "Begin a New Generation (BANG)").
- 39. Plaintiff was unable to find any record of "Begin a New Generation" as a registered entity on the Arkansas Secretary of State website. However, on information and belief, the entity referred to in the invoice is associated with "Bang House of Barbers, LLC," a registered limited

liability company. The address listed on the purchase order corresponds to a private apartment complex.

40. Like the prior donations, this payment was made without any written agreement or contract for services between the City of Fort Smith and "Begin a New Generation," which may also be known as Bang House of Barbers, LLC. Moreover, this \$2,006.99 donation of taxpayer funds constitutes an unlawful expenditure to a private, for-profit business.

CONSTITUTIONAL VIOLATIONS AND ILLEGAL EXACTION

41. Article 12, Section 5 of the Arkansas Constitution prohibits municipalities from appropriating public funds for private purposes. The relevant provision states:

"No county, city, town or other municipal corporation shall become a stockholder in any company, association, or corporation; or obtain or appropriate money for, or loan its credit to, any corporation, association, institution or individual."

- 42. Article 16, Section 13 of the Arkansas Constitution empowers taxpayers to challenge the misuse of public funds, providing: "Any citizen of any county, city, or town may institute suit to protect the inhabitants thereof against the enforcement of any illegal exactions whatever."
- 43. The Arkansas Supreme Court held that even if a private nonprofit corporation serves a public purpose, municipal expenditures in its favor are still impermissible under Article 12, Section 5. *Halbert v. Helena-West Helena Indus. Dev. Corp.*, 226 Ark. 620, 625, 291 S.W.2d 802, 805 (1956).
- 44. Similarly, the Arkansas Attorney General has interpreted Article 12, Section 5 of the Arkansas Constitution to broadly prohibit grants or donations of public funds to any private entity, including nonprofit organizations, regardless of the nature or purpose of the entity. *Ark. Op. Att'y Gen. No. 2005-205*.

45. These rulings make clear that while nonprofits may have commendable missions

or "exalted purposes," municipalities are constitutionally barred from donating public funds to

private entities, regardless of their aims. Public funds must remain dedicated to serving public

purposes directly benefiting the community as a whole.

46. The unlawful expenditures detailed in Counts 1 through 6 violate Article 12,

Section 5 of the Arkansas Constitution and constitute illegal exactions under Article 16, Section

13. Plaintiff seeks declaratory and injunctive relief to ensure compliance with these constitutional

mandates and to prevent further misuse of taxpayer funds.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff respectfully requests a declaratory judgment that the expenditures

described in Counts 1 through 6 violated Article 12, Section 5 and Article 16, Section 13 of the

Arkansas Constitution; a permanent injunction prohibiting the City of Fort Smith from making

unauthorized donations, sponsorships, or payments of public funds to private entities or

authorizing any expenditure of public funds for private purposes in violation of the Arkansas

Constitution; an award of attorney's fees and costs as permitted by law; and such other and further

relief as the Court deems just and proper.

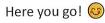
